




With its whitewashed façade, tiled roof, and 17 rooms opening onto the ocean, Les Hautes Mers hotel is both a refuge and an overseas journey, where the smell of iodine and the infinite palette of marine colours redefine the perception of time and space.



A UNIQUE POINT OF VIEW

17 rooms and suites, all with private terraces, most with sea views.

Rates ranging from $200 \in to 550 \in in$ high season for a surface area from 18 to $30m^2$.



GASTRONOMY

Located in front of the ocean, Vent Debout has a breathtaking view of the Ker Chalon Bay. Chef Nawal Reazagui offers a resolutely contemporary, generous, fresh, and unique cuisine that highlights seafood products from local producers.

15 minutes away by bike, the Bar de la Meule is an unusual addition to the hotel. Its walls are covered with old photographs and engravings illustrating fishing and marine life and its wooden tables offer scallop carpaccio, tuna tartare or samphire risotto that you can enjoy after a long walk. From spring on, the terrace extends onto the beach facing the renowned fishermen huts typical from L'Ile d'Yeu.
